OCC gift boxes represent one of the largest children's evangelism efforts worldwide, reaching children around the globe, including those in hard-to-reach areas. Samaritan's Purse collaborates with local churches to share the Gospel with children, deliver the gift boxes packed by donors, and invite them to the 12-lesson discipleship program called 'The Greatest Journey'. Additionally, OCC gift boxes support local churches and help them grow, enabling ongoing discipleship.




FRUITS OF THE MINISTRY



Since 1993, we have delivered approximately 220 million gift boxes to children in 176 countries and territories around the world. In 2023, 11 countries participated in reaching 11.3 million children with OCC gift boxes and the joy of the Gospel.



2023 Statistics




11.3 million gift boxes collected

THE JOURNEY OF A GIFT BOX

You can easily join by packing gift boxes with your family or with your church community.

It's more than just sending gifts; it's about sharing the Gospel.

Millions of children learn about Jesus and become His disciples through the 12-lesson discipleship program called 'The Greatest Journey.'

What is 'The Greatest Journey'?



When children receive their gift boxes through outreach events organized by local churches, they are also invited to participate in a 12-lesson discipleship program

called 'The Greatest Journey.' Trained local ministers provide the discipleship training and upon completion, children receive a graduation certificate and a copy of the New Testament Bible in their local language.

- Equipping volunteers
- Training local church workers
- Evangelizing the greater community

How are OCC Gift Boxes Delivered?

OCC gift boxes are delivered through local churches and partners to children who hear the Gospel first before receiving the gift.



Q. When are OCC gift boxes delivered to the children?


After the packed OCC gift boxes are collected in Korea, they are incorporated into our global logistics system before arriving at the final destination country. Due to the varying transportation conditions of each country, the arrival time of the gift boxes may vary.

Q. Can I choose which country will receive my gift box?

The recipient countries of OCC gift boxes change every year. In 2024, the OCC gift boxes prepared in Korea are scheduled to be shipped to Ukraine, the Philippines, Mongolia, and hard-to-reach areas.

Opportunity to Share the Gospel

In a remote village in southern Madagascar, Pastor Soja, along with OCC gift box ministry partners, shared the Gospel with a tribe steeped in superstition for generations. The seeds planted became the foundation for establishing churches in a village that was once hostile to Christianity.





An Unforgettable Good Day

St. Andrew's region in Grenada is rampant with drugs, crime, and gambling, and most children are left unattended without parents. Upon receiving the gift box delivered to the area, young Joshua exclaimed, "Today is the best day ever! I love everything inside!" The gift boxes bring light to places that seem covered in darkness.

God Who Knows All Needs

A 13-year-old boy from South Africa who desperately needed a new set of clothes found clothes in the box that fit him perfectly and couldn't hide his joy. Experiencing God's meticulous provision, the boy and his family accepted Jesus as their Savior.



A Channel of Answered Prayer

Elena and her daughter fled to Poland to escape the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. Despite the fear that overwhelmed them in the face of their reality, they prayed for protection for their family. The OCC gift box they received brought them great comfort and joy.



We walked for an hour and a half carrying 80 boxes.

50 university students took the initiative to deliver gift boxes to an isolated village in the Bolo region of Liberia. They walked through the jungle for an hour and a half to deliver the gift boxes to the children. These gift boxes became the seed of the Gospel in the remote village, eventually leading to the establishment of a church.

The moment I opened the gift box, it felt like I had the whole world!

Vanessa, a girl from Honduras, who was anxious about being expelled from school for not being able to pay tuition, did not have many happy memories. On the day she received the gift box, Vanessa discovered a wonderful pencil set and warm pink socks and couldn't hide her joy. "These are the things I wanted," she said, filled with the assurance that Jesus knows her needs.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE WITH YOUR CHURCH OR ORGANIZATION



O Pray and set goals

Pray together with your community and set a target number of OCC gift boxes to be sent in 2024. Have prayer meetings for the children who will receive the gift boxes.



Order OCC gift boxes

Order the gift boxes and receive the participation kit through the Samaritan's Purse Korea website.

- Gift box orders are available in QTY of 50.
- The participation kit includes promotional materials (X-banner, mini banner, poster) for use in churches/organizations. (Refer to p.18)



Promote OCC gift boxes in your community (Refer to p.18, 19)

Introduce the OCC gift box ministry to your church/organization and explain how to participate.

- Use the videos and brochures provided by Samaritan's Purse Korea.
- Set up displays and information desks using the promotional materials included in the participation kit.
- Distribute gift boxes, postcards, rubber bands, and donation envelopes.
- Emphasize the collection date, location, and introduce the Project Leader (PL)
- Explain the purpose of the 20,000 KRW donation per OCC gift box and how to make the donation.

Occlear Occ gift boxes

Bring the collected OCC gift boxes to a nearby drop-off location or mail to the Samaritan's Purse warehouse during National Collection Week which is from November 18-25th.

What is a Drop-off Center?

Drop-off locations are designated sites that form a network of centralized locations where local churches, organizations, and individuals participating in OCC can drop off their packed gift boxes.

Gift Box Delivery Methods (Choose one):

Bring them directly to a drop-off center in your area.
Ship via courier to the Samaritan's Purse warehouse

Send donation and donor information

A donation of 20,000 KRW per gift box is critical to cover discipleship material, shipping and other project costs.

1. Individual Donations | Individuals packing gift boxes through a participating organization can make their donation directly on the Samaritan's Purse Korea website or by using the QR code on the gift box. Donation receipts can only be issued for donors who donate through the website.

2. Group Donations using Donation Envelopes | Individual donations collected through OCC donation envelopes can be transferred to the Samaritan's Purse Korea account. For account details, please contact our office at 02-2105-1800 (press 1) during business hours from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, excluding weekends and public holidays.

*Please note that for organizations that are able to issue donation receipts, Samaritan's Purse Korea cannot issue additional receipts for individual donors who used the donation envelopes.

ADDITIONAL WAYS TO GET INVOLVED



Packing Party: Sharing the Joy of Missions

Host a packing party where you can gather with loved ones to prepare gift boxes and celebrate the joy of spreading the Gospel! Gather together with participants from your church or group to pack gifts for children on the other side of the world, share the joy of giving, and experience a special missions opportunity through intercessory prayer.



How? Set a target number of gift boxes, prepare gift items,

and carefully pack the boxes. Include a warm handwritten letter and pray together that the child will receive the Gospel. Finally, take a group photo and share it on social media to capture the precious moment.



Volunteering for Overseas Missions 1. Collecting OCC Gift Boxes at Drop-off Centers

Drop-off centers collect OCC gift boxes within the community during National Collection Week. Volunteers communicate with donors and help raise awareness of the OCC gift box ministry in the area.

2. Inspecting OCC Gift Boxes at Processing Centers

In December 2024, volunteers will gather at the processing center to inspect the items in the gift boxes to ensure they are suitable for overseas delivery. This is a great opportunity for church members and group participants to serve together. Join in spreading the Gospel worldwide through OCC gift boxes!

3. Participating in Samaritan's Purse Korea Packing Party

In February 2025, come volunteer by participating in a fun packing party organized by Samaritan's Purse Korea to share Jesus' love with children in hard-to-reach areas.

- **Team Leader**: Focuses on recruiting, leading, and developing teams of volunteers in order to accomplish the mission of Operation Christmas Child.
- **Church Relations**: Builds and cultivates relationships with local churches to participate in Operation Christmas Child, fulfilling the Great Commission though the ministry.
- **Prayer**: Mobilizes prayer in their area interceding for the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the ministry.
- Logistics: Collaborates in identifying and establishing potential drop-off centers in the area.
- **Community Relations**: Promotes OCC gift boxes and encourages participation at various local events and gatherings by engaging and equipping groups, businesses, and civic organizations.
